- □ 1 Wide ruled Composition book
  - □ 5- 3-hole punched **plastic** dividers
  - □ 1- 3-hole punched canvas zippered supply pouch (NO PENCIL BOXES)
  - □ 1 package of college-ruled paper
  - □ 12 sharpened pencils (4 needed at school at all times) no mechanical pencils
  - □ 1 pack of colored pencils (12 or 24)
  - $\Box$  3 highlighters, each a different color (will also be needed for Latin)
